CREATE STABILITY

Putting down roots in a stable location is essential to reach South CLT and our South Carolina neighbors.

STRENGTHEN DISCIPLESHIP

Our neighborhoods are increasingly unchurched and Jesus calls us to be generous with the gospel.


- → Support new regional church plants and new international church planting partnerships



A Heart of Generosity

"For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." In Matthew 6:21, Jesus is teaching that what we give our money to is what we tend to love the most. This means when we invest the resources God has given us back into his church and his kingdom, those things become our passion. For this reason, ask new questions about your giving and generosity so that we might mature in our love for God and his church at South CLT Pres. As you consider The Generosity Road below, try to identify what question you are currently asking about money and which part of the road characterizes your giving. Prayerfully consider taking a turn toward greater generosity.

THE GENEROSITY ROAD



What do I do with my money?

<u>Potential givers</u> are moving in practice from owners to stewards. They have taken the first step of faith and invested something financially in God's church and his kingdom.

What do I do with God's money?

Occasional givers are beginning to understand the concept of biblical stewardship. They haven't yet developed a regular pattern of giving and don't yet give a certain percentage, but they give.

What does God say to do with God's money?

Intentional givers have an understanding that God owns everything. They give consistently, but they haven't yet reached 10%.

What does God want me to give from God's resources?

<u>Tithers</u> believe God owns everything. They live off 90% and invest 10% in his kingdom.

What does God want me to keep from God's resources?

<u>Generous givers</u> live out their belief that God owns everything. They keep only what they need while investing the rest in his kingdom.

Creative Mays to Ogive

Your margin for giving may feel much smaller than you'd like it to feel. That's not unusual! But often as we expand our vision to include all of the resources that God has given to us, we begin to see new avenues for generosity we hadn't initially considered. You may be amazed at your capacity to give! The following seven options are suggested as a means to help you consider some creative ways to give.

(.	Practice priority budgeting	Many families will choose to rearrange their priorities and give up something in their current budget in order to give more. Priority budgeting may mean postponing a planned expenditure, like a new car, vacation, home remodel, or other major purchase.
2.	Increase giving with increased income	We often increase our standard of living when we receive a raise or a bonus. Some families elect to keep their standard of living the same and increase their giving by the amount of the raise or bonus.
3.	Redirect current expenditures	Families often have short-term expenses factored into their budget. When those expenses end, those funds can be redirected without major budget adjustments. For example, a family that pays off a loan may choose to continue budgeting the same amount of the loan payment as a gift.
4.	Sacrifice your extra time	Extra time can be converted into extra income and greater giving capacity through part-time jobs.
5.	Donate stored resources	Appreciated assets (like stocks or real estate) can also be resources for generosity. Talk to a financial advisor for ways to maximize these gifts.
6.	Give from your excess	Some families save over a period of years for a special project. Funds initially saved for vacations, new vehicles, or other projects can be redirected as gifts.
7.	Commit unexpected	Sudden influxes of cash due to an inheritance, a second income, or gifts can be added to gifts from regular income.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the financial goal of this initiative?

Our goal is \$2,500,000 over a 2-year period. We will need maximum participation from those who call South CLT Pres home in order to raise this amount of money. This initiative is roughly \$1,000,000 (66%) more than we expect to receive in regular givings in 2023-24.

Why are we doing this now?

Our church is growing and reaching our community, but we have an opportunity to do even more. We want to have maximum kingdom impact as we pursue what God has in store for us. We believe God has given us health and momentum for such a time as this. The time is soon coming when we will need to provide a stable space for the children's ministry and worship. We are preparing for this challenge.

How can I grow in my giving?

In the future, South CLT Pres will be starting discipleship groups for financial stewardship taught through a biblical lens.

Can my gift involve stocks or other assets in addition to cash?

When do my gifts count towards the Abound Campaign?

All gifts to South CLT Pres from December 11, 2022 through December 31, 2024 will count towards the Abound Initiative.

Are my gifts "over and above" my normal tithes and other offerings?

We are taking a "One Fund" approach to the Abound Initiative. That means all giving is rolled into one budget (as opposed to keeping ministry and projects separate). With giving campaigns people typically give to one and/or the other, whereas with this One Fund initiative, everyone is giving to support the mission and vision of the church including facilities.

When will we be asked to make our commitment?

Commitment Sunday is November 13, 2022.

What will take place on Commitment Sunday?

On Commitment Sunday we will worship, celebrate, and pray over what God has planned for the coming years at South CLT Pres. We will ask our entire church to participate by committing to give financially to the Abound Initiative. We ask that everyone submit their Commitment Card, in-person or online (scan the QR code on the back of this booklet), at the end of our worship agthering.

Can financial commitments be changed if necessary?

Absolutely. We understand that life circumstances can alter our ability to give generously in negative and positive ways. If you need to change your commitment, please email admin@southcltpres.org.
